

## Request to Modify or Correct an Arbitration Decision

Section 30 of the Arbitration Rules allows the parties to an arbitration to request the Arbitrator(s) to modify or correct the arbitration decision for any of the grounds listed below. You must submit your request to the BYU Center for Conflict Resolution (CCR) in writing within **twenty calendar days** after service of the decision. The CCR will share your observation with the other parties who may state their objections in writing within ten calendar days after receipt of notice. The CCR will forward the views of all parties to the Arbitrator, who may modify the decision in whole or in part or confirm it altogether. The decision of the Arbitrator(s) to modify the decision shall be made no later than twenty calendar days from the receipt of the statements to the Arbitrator(s), otherwise the decision is confirmed as originally given. Appeals of an arbitration decision may be taken to a court of competent jurisdiction in Utah for specifically defined grounds within 90 days after service of the decision (see UCA 78-31a-124 and 125).
